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In response to Shoreline Fire Departments "Request for Information" on the Engineering, Demolition, and Installation of a reliable HVAC system for Stations 64 and 65, on June 14th at 1:00 PM, Shoreline Fire Department publically opened three proposals, which are available through request at Shoreline Fire Department 17525 Aurora Ave. N.

The proposals varied greatly with regard to solutions as well as pricing. Without describing each of the proposed solutions, the following are the basic pricing assumptions that were provided with each:

PSR -	\$162,178 w/o tax and including alternates
Johnson Controls -	\$50,851.80 w/tax
MacDonald Miller-	\$26,147 w/tax

Shoreline Fire Department has contracted with Syder+Byers as a consulting Engineer to help evaluate the merits of each of the proposals and to make a final recommendation as to the best solution for our needs.

Due to the wide range of proposed solutions and pricing, the initial timelines established in Shoreline Fire Departments request will be pushed into August so that our third party engineer has time to properly evaluate each of the solutions, help Shoreline negotiate for a final solution, and acceptance test the final installation.

Shoreline Fire Department would like to thank each of the three Contractors that submitted proposals and will be contacting each for discussions about their proposal in the near future.
