Here's a look at Shoreline's busiest day last week, with 20 9-1-1 calls in a 24 hour period.

- 12:45 A 46-year old male suffering from chest pain after drinking heavily. Believes he has broken ribs.
- 3:03 An unknown age male is reported to be slumped over the wheel of his car, unresponsive.
- 5:04 A 78-year old female complaining of cardiac symptoms and rapid heart rate.
- 7:05 A mother reports her 15 year old son is having difficulty breathing after a dental appointment.
- 9:16 A resident reports smoldering logs on the beach near the Highlands.
- 9:35 A 79-year old female is suffering from a severe headache.
- 10:02 A Highlands resident's automatic fire alarm is sounding. No fire...possible alarm malfunction.
- 10:07 A 63-year old female suffered cuts and bruises after a fall at home.
- 10:10 An automatic fire alarm at Fircrest School, no fire. Alarm malfunction.
- 10:37 An automatic fire alarm at Northridge I, possible alarm malfunction. No fire.
- 12:07 An 81-year old female is injured in a fall at home.
- 12:11 An automatic fire alarm, multi-family residence. No fire. Malicious pull.
- 13:32 A 53-year old female fell at home and could not get up.
- 15:36 An 80 year old female suffered bruises after a fall at a nursing facility.
- 16:11 A 60 year old male fell out of a wheelchair at Saltwater Park, firefighters had to use a gator vehicle to help rescue him and return him to his adult family home.
- 16:28 Three people suffered minor injuries in a 3-car crash on 15th NE.
- 19:33 Northwest Church of Christ reports smoke in the basement. Someone accidentally discharged a fire extinguisher.
- 19:45 A 66-year old male is reportedly choking. Firefighters arrive to find him breathing normally.
- 20:45 A male in his 60's suffered a seizure at home.
- 23:14 A 37-year old male reports severe abdominal pain.
